## Dussehra Rally: both Senas Locked horns

n the occasion of Dussehra festival its tradition of Bala Saheb's shiv sena to call for public gathering. Both Shiv Sena factions had 'Dussehra Melava' (annual public gathering). After the split in the Shiv Sena in the year 2022, CM Eknath Shinde had organized a rally for the first time at BKC, While UBT Shiv Sena Uddhav Thackeray's rally was at usual place in Shivaji Park, Dadar. The divided Shiv Sainik's were disappointed because the traditional Melava of sena has taken a painful turn of alleging each other.

"You back-stabbed Bal Thackeray by committing dishonesty with his ideological legacy. I won't be surprised if they ally with terrorist groups like Hamas and Lashkar-e-Taiba for their own selfish motives," says Maharashtra CM Eknath Shinde while addressing the Dussehra rally of Shiv Sena

On Maharashtra CM Eknath Shinde's statement, Shiv Sena (UBT) leader Priyanka Chaturvedi says, "They know that people's support is with Maha Vikas Aghadi. They know that they will lose when the elections would be there. The people of Maharashtra would make them lose. They can compare us with Hamas, ISIS or anyone. In a true sense, the real anti-nationals are those who are toppling the elected governments, and those who are neglecting the agencies and the Constitution, and reducing the rules of democracy. And they are the BJP and their one or two alliance partners..."

Some leader also expressed their views when asked about the difference seen at the recent rally, BJP MLA Nitesh Rane told Afternoon Voice, "Now-a-days rally is all about allegations as Uddhav Thackeray was also seen blaming BJP for the Shiv Sena crisis which is not right as

earlier when late Bal Thackeray had initiated the rally it only talked about issues faced by people, Marathi people, direction to Shiv Sainiks but now concept of this rally is changed".

When both the Shiv Sena factions had kept the rally on the same day leaders were seen talking about involvement of other political parties into the scams and the functioning of the government over this other political parties also expressed their views and mentioned that 'To some extent', Yes said NCP spokesperson of Sharad Pawar faction.

### Chintan a celebrated artist caged in Hema Upadhyay's murder

woman born in Baroda Hema met her future husband and fellow artist Chintan Upadhyay in 1992. They both fell in love due to the common interest and professional convenience. Chintan and Hema got married in 1998, and settled in Mumbai. Initially they had a beautiful life, they worked together in many exhibitions. Later on, things were not normal between them. Profession egos and compatibility issues took their personal life on toll. Chintan Upadhyay's personal diary, filled with grievances about the breakdown of their marriage, played a crucial role in the case. Entries in the diary reflected his thoughts on the divorce and his puzzlement about why Hema, who seemed indifferent to him, wanted revenge. Hema's career was at its peak, she had her first solo ex-

hibition, titled Sweet Sweat Memories, at Gallery Chemould, now Chemould Prescott road (Mumbai), in 2001. The exhibition consisted of mixed media on paper works. In these works, she has incorporated her own photographs to communicate her ideas of migration having moved to Bombay in 1998. Hema's paintings were usually characterised by the inclusion of small-collaged photographic self-portraits.

In 2013, Hema filed a harassment case against Chintan for drawing obscene sketches of her on the walls of their apartment. Haresh Bhambani was her lawyer for this case. She lost when the case ruled the bedroom as Chintan's personal space.

Their divorce was completed in 2014, after which Chintan moved to Delhi and Hema lived in their flat on the Juhu-Tara Road. Bhambani then took on as Hema's lawyer in the alimony proceedings. Hema wanted Rs 200,000 per month. The court brought it down to Rs 40,000 per month. On the day of their murders, Chintan had paid Bhambani Rs 200,000 in lump sum as alimony. Chintan Upadhyay, then ordered the killing of his wife and her lawyer, owing to a long, messy, ugly and expensive legal and personal battle with her during their marriage and after the divorce. Hema's body had been found along with that of her lawyer Harish Bhambhani, wrapped in plastic and put in boxes in a drain in the northern Mumbai suburb of Kandivali on December 12, 2015.

Vidyadhar, after killing Hema and Bhambhani, took a train to Varanasi from Dadar around 9.30 PM on 11 December along with the arrested accused Shivkumar Rajbhar. After reaching Itarsi, Madhya Pradesh, Vidyadhar tells Shivkumar that he wants to surrender to the police and gets off the train. His phone was last traceable on 13 December 2015. Then, on 2 February 2016, his phone was traced when he called a cousin in Surat from Chennai. The police rushed to Chennai, but he was nowhere to be found. Eight days later, on 10 February, his phone was traced to Guwahati, Assam after which the trail went cold. On 13 September 2016, the police even set up an elaborate trap, complete with personnel in plainclothes. It was Vidyadhar's daughter's first birthday, and the police made an educated guess that he would show up; especially since his family had sold off a room in their house for Rs 35 lakh.

Vidyadhar Rajbhar, owner of Vanshraj Arts, he would do art fabrication work for Hema, is a main accused to have planned the murders and strangled Hema. Hema used to store her artwork at his warehouse. The reason for Hema and Bhambhani visit to the Kandivali warehouse on the night of their murder was, a fabricator she shared with Chintan. Vidyadhar had promised to show them compromising video clips involving Chintan, leading them to the location where they were killed. Vidyadhar was close to Chintan Upadhyay's family. In fact, his father named him after Chintan's father. Chintan also footed Vidyadhar's father's medical expenses up to Rs 5 lakhs. With the help of Vijay Rajbhar, a tempo driver who dumped the bodies in the drain. Third accused, Pradeep Rajbhar who killed Haresh Bhambani, a lawyer of Hema. He also lured Hema with "evidence" of her estranged husband Chintan sleeping with girls and offered her a proposition to buy these clips for two lakh rupees. Fourth accused Shivkumar Rajbhar helped

Vijay to kill Haresh Bhambani. Fifth accused, Azad Rajbhar who is cousin of Vidyadhar who came down to Mumbai from UP in 2015 on his invitation to work with him at his workshop in 2015. He is being tried as a minor on account of being 16 when the murders took place.

On December 11, 2015, the bodies of Hema and her lawyer Harish Bhambhani were found dumped in a nullah in Kandivali. The trial court found Chintan guilty of abetting and conspiring to murder Hema, while it found three others, Pradeep, Vijay and Shivkumar, guilty of murdering Hema and Bhambhani. Chintan, who spent six years in jail since his arrest in 2015, was granted bail by the Supreme Court in 2021. After he was convicted, he was arrested and sent to jail again.

Chintan Upadhyay was a celebrated artist and a recipient of Charles Wallace Foundation Award. He began as a painter and later began creating sculptures and installations, the surfaces of which he painted. His best-known sculpture project is believed to be the Pet Shop project, which is an ongoing production of a "model baby" for every season, a Baby fetish. For these works, Upadhyay collaborated with artist Manish Sharma, a Rajasthani miniatures painter, who covered the babies with his interpretations of Indian miniatures. Chintan Upadhyay and controversies went hand in hand. While his contentious works often made headlines one of the most prominent controversies was when the artist sat in the buff and asked people to smear him with saffron, thus reclaiming the colour in a ritualistic manner at the height of the Gujarat riots. The artist courted another controversy when he impersonated a pregnant woman and dressed up in a house dress.

The conviction of artist Chintan Upadhyay for conspiracy in the murder of his estranged wife, Hema Upadhyay, marks a significant development in this high-profile case. While the main accused, Vidyadhar Rajbhar, remains at large, Chintan's conviction is based on a combination of evidence, including his personal diary and the discovery of the bodies. The case has shed light on the complexities of personal and professional relationships within the art world and the tragic consequences that can result from such conflicts.







## Israel-Hamas war: iconic rock band, B-52s won't be performing at a White House dinner for Australian PM due to 'Sorrow'



he iconic rock band, B-52s, will no longer perform at a White House dinner for Australian Prime Minister Anthony Albanese due to the "sorrow" of the Israel-Hamas war, The Times of Israel quoted US First Lady Jill Biden as saying. The band, best known for the 1989 hit "Love Shack," was scheduled to play at the state dinner for Prime Minister Anthony Albanese on Wednesday hosted by President Joe Biden.

"While we had initially planned for the legendary B-52s to perform their iconic dance and party music, we are now in a time when so many are facing sorrow

and pain, and we have decided to make adjustments to the entertainment portion of the evening," Jill Biden told the reporters. The New Wave band, named after a US bomber aircraft but more famous for their beehive hairdos, will still take part in the state dinner but as guests, she adds. Presidential military bands would provide "instrumental music" instead, the US First Lady also said.

Jill Biden made the announcement during a preview for the dinner, which will feature a guest chef, dishes including sarsaparilla-braised short ribs and design featuring US and Australian elements, as reported by The Times of Israel. Albanese arrived at the White House on Tuesday ahead of a formal state visit on Wednesday when he is expected to discuss topics including China, Ukraine, and the Israel-Hamas war.

A day ago, US President Joe Biden and Saudi Arabian Crown Prince Mohammed bin Salman discussed the conflict between Israel and Hamas during a phone call, the White House said. The two leaders spoke about "ongoing diplomatic and military efforts to deter state and non-state actors from widening the conflict" and agreed to pursue "broader diplomatic efforts to maintain stability across the region and prevent the conflict from expanding," according to the White House. The two also affirmed the importance of working towards a sustainable peace between Israelis and Palestinians as soon as the crisis subsides, "building on" the work that was already underway between Saudi Arabia and the United States over recent months before the outbreak of the Gaza

# China: President Xi Jinping said, "Beijing is ready to work with Washington to manage differences"

iting the impact of US-China relations on world peace and development, Chinese President Xi Jinping said that Beijing is ready to work with Washington, to "properly manage differences", contribute to each other's progress and push for common prosperity, Chinese state media agency Xinhua reported on Wednesday. Xi stated that China is willing to work with the US based on three principles of "mutual respect, peaceful coexistence and win-win cooperation".

"As two major countries in the world, whether China and the United States can find a right path of state-to-state interactions bears on world peace and development, and the future of mankind," Jinping said. He added, "Based on the three principles of mutual respect, peaceful coexistence and win-win cooperation, China is willing to work with the US side to advance mutually beneficial cooperation, properly manage differences, and make

joint efforts to tackle global challenges, contribute to each other's progress, and push for common prosperity so as to deliver benefits to both countries and the whole world". In a congratulatory message to the annual Gala Dinner of the National Committee on US-China Relations, Xi applauded the committee's longstanding dedication to the exchanges and cooperation between the two countries in various areas, Xinhua reported. He also congratulated former US Secretary of State Henry Kissinger on winning an accolade at the gala.

The Chinese president further voiced hope that the committee and friends from all walks of life will continue to concern themselves with and support China-US relations and play a constructive role in promoting the sound and steady growth of bilateral ties. US President Joe Biden also sent a congratulatory message to the Gala Dinner of the committee, Xinhua reported. **ANI** 

## Herat earthquake: UNICEF reports at least 80 tons of medical assistance to victims

he United Nations Children's Fund (UNICEF) has reported that at least 80 tons of medical assistance have arrived in Kabul to aid families affected by earthquakes in Herat, according to Khaama Press. This aid which includes medicine and medical equipment, is specifically designated to support 43,000 families who have been impacted by recent earthquakes in Herat.

UNICEF has confirmed that these goods, which also include medications and medical gear, were shipped from UNICEF's Copenhagen warehouse to Afghanistan. These supplies are intended to benefit young people, expectant mothers, and families in Herat who have been impacted



by numerous severe earthquakes, Khaama Press reported.

Prior to this, Herat had received aid from a number of nations and humanitarian organisations, and the United Arab Emirates had opened a mobile hospital there.

UNICEF has pledged to continue its humanitarian efforts over

the next three months, with a commitment to aid around 200,000 individuals, including 96,000 children, according to Khaama Press. The agency's commitment

to having a positive impact on the community is highlighted by the continued support that is essential in giving relief and bettering the lives of individuals affected by the disaster. Several relief organisations have stated that the terrible earthquake in Herat damaged dozens of houses and resulted in over 4,000 casualties.

Herat earthquake victims are pleading with the Taliban and international humanitarian organisations for permanent refuge. According to them, the chilly weather and their children's illnesses make living difficult under dire circumstances. The extent of the disaster's effects on the afflicted areas has brought to light the province's urgent need for humanitarian relief. ANI
